

Northwest Territories:

If an indoor masking order is issued, the following are exceptions:

- Children under two years of age
- Children two years of age or older but less than ten years of age who is unable to tolerate wearing a face mask.
- People unable to put on or remove their face mask without assistance.
- People unable to wear a face mask due to a medical reason.
- People providing or receiving care or assistance, where a face mask would interfere with that care or assistance.
- People who do not wear a face mask as a result of an emergency.
- People who remove their face mask temporarily for identification purposes; and
- People otherwise approved by the Chief Public Health Officer as not required to wear a mask.

Masks aren't recommended for:

- People who suffer from illnesses or disabilities that make it difficult to put on or take off a mask
- Those who have difficulty breathing
- Children under the age of two years
- Those who are unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance
